Hidden away behind the railway in Kidbrooke, this brand-new facility cares for items not currently on display in the world-famous collections of ROYAL MUSEUMS, GREENWICH.

We have the opportunity to see some of these 2.5 million treasures and meet conservation experts, visiting their studios and learning how they prepare and restore artefacts for display. We will witness conservation in action and come face to face with the museums' personal stories relating to the Titanic, Antarctic expeditions, and migration.

It is not often that Museums open their working spaces to visitors, and it promises to be a fascinating insight into the unseen skills that support and maintain the collections of the Maritime Museum itself, the Cutty Sark, The Queen's House and The Observatory.
